



Directions

Please follow these directions and DO NOT rely on your GPS system. We think the village has been wrongly plotted and you may get lost - they normally lead you into the wrong end of the village where the streets are particularly narrow (built for donkeys and not for vehicles!).

El Gastor is just off the main Ronda/Algodonales/Seville road - the A374.

Keep an eye out for the km signs on the side of the road as the ONLY El Gastor turning you should take is between km 6 and 7 - any other of the El Gastor turn offs will bring you into the wrong end of the village and you'll end up having to navigate the narrow streets.

Follow the signs to El Gastor. After about 3 kms on this road you will see a metal armco barrier on the left and a CA-9114 km3 sign - after another 700 metres there is a small group of white houses on your left and an ornamental water trough called the Fuente de Gato on the right.

Just after the trough you will see a concrete road - turn right here, it is signposted to Algarrobales and there is a 70km speed sign just before it.

If you pass a petrol station on your left you have missed the turning and have gone too far and will need to turn around.

Take this road up into the pine trees, where it forks, bear left. This brings you down into a parking area. Our house is the 3rd on the left - number 20.
